- **Students Provide School Counselor with their Picture:** Students will need to provide a picture of themselves and send the picture to their counselor through email (see contact information above). - **Please do the following when if you are taking your picture to send back to the school:**

 - The background in the picture should be blank or empty (Example; white wall, wall or background empty of pictures or other).
- **Appropriate Attire / Dress Code:** Please wear appropriate *business attire* when taking your picture. Some examples would be a collared shirt, tie, suit long pants, or a dress, pant suit, etc.
